The Phar Lap Trust was formed to bring to reality a memorial to Phar Lap, foaled at Seadown Timaru, New Zealand on 4th October 1926 and subsequently sold at the yearling sales.

A life-sized statue is proposed of the Champion Racehorse in full gallop, ridden by his regular jockey, Jim Pike and demonstrating his impressive galloping stride.

Phar Lap stands for many admirable attributes, including perseverance, excellence, determination and the ability to rise above perception and the enduring qualities of a true champion. Even today his name is frequently used as a bench mark of excellence to analyze the highest level of performance.

PHAR LAP TRUST - Code of Ethics and Conduct

The Phar Lap Trust is a Charitable Trust approved and registered with the Inland Revenue Department. Contributions to the Trust will be placed in a Trust Account held at Public Trust until invoices for work undertaken in relation to the project are presented.
